Sub:- Manning of Group 'C' and 'D' posts in Railway Claims Tribunal.

Ref:- Railway Claims Tribunal, Delhi's letter No.RCT/DLI/Admin Policy/2016, dated 19.01.2018 on the subject captioned above.

The proposal of Railway Claims Tribunal (RCT), Delhi to allow filling up the vacancies of Group 'C' & 'D' in RCTs from any Zones/Divisions of Indian Railways on transfer/tenure basis without restricting the territorial jurisdiction of Divisions/ Zones has been examined in Board's office. Board have agreed with the proposal of RCT and decided to modify the relevant Para - 4 of the Board's Circular No.2000/TC(RCT)/8-1 dated 01.10.2007 (copy enclosed) as under:

"4. The Tribunals may accordingly approach Railway Zones/Divisions irrespective of territorial jurisdiction of the Tribunals for their requirement of staff from time to time well in advance of occurrence of vacancy. The Railways will give wide publicity to the requirement of staff for the RCT and forward particulars of all eligible staff to the RCT for making the final selection. In no case, the Tribunals should make direct recruitment in any category of the staff in the Tribunals or effect promotion of Railway staff working with them on tenure basis".

2. The other terms and conditions mentioned in Board's letter No.2000/TC(RCT)/8-1 dated 01.10.2007 will remain unchanged.
3. This issues in consultation with Establishment Directorate of Ministry of Railways.
